## A MESSAGE FROM STEVE CHRISMAN, AIRPORT MANAGER

There has been a lot happening at the once very sleepy Eastern Oregon Regional Airport. This summer and fall will prove no different as we break ground on several new projects, both public and private. Understandably, the question has been asked by the public and even some public employees, *why are we spending millions of dollars on an airport that has been a perennial loser for many years?* That's a fair question and here is the honest answer:



Pendleton is at the forefront of an evolution in aerospace technology.

Unmanned systems are rapidly entering the commercial marketplace.

Billions of public and private \$\$ are pouring into Unmanned Aerial Service (UAS) commercialization.

We are the most active UAS test range on the West Coast and home to several large projects.

The Test Range is attracting new companies: Pacific Northwest National Laboratories; Digital Harvest; Yamaha Motor Corporation;

MTSI; A<sup>3</sup> by Airbus; PAEISR; Cubic ISR; and others.

On an average week, there have been 50-70 UAS workers here, working 5-7 days a week, eating and drinking at restaurants, staying in hotels, shopping, and now starting to buy houses and call this home. These kinds of high-tech, high-paying jobs (over 3 times County average wage) are very hard to attract into rural Oregon. However, we possess something they need: special FAA permissions; specialized infrastructure and equipment; empty airspace; fast internet; highly-skilled staff, and up until recently...empty hangars and workshops.

Unfortunately, the true scale of this opportunity is unknown, but based on the distance customers will travel (OR-2; WA-3; CA-4; VA-2; MD-2; PA-1) and how much they enjoy operating here, we believe it's the tip of the iceberg. Our biggest weakness is the lack of available hangars, workshop space, and shovel-ready ground. We have good reason to believe that companies would fill them and that some companies would even build facilities if they existed.

Timing is everything. Great opportunities must be seized. They will not wait for the slow and the short-sighted. Comparisons some have made to the "Road to Nowhere" are ill-conceived or even maliciously intended to mislead. The UAS range has already proven its ability to bring companies, commerce, and employment to Pendleton. Airport Road is now the "The Road to the Pendleton UAS Range", and any future development along it will likely be as a result of the range.

Coming projects in FY 2019/2020:

Primary Runway 7-25 Rehab: FAA provided \$7 million grant with only 5% City match. Unrelated to the range, but saved over \$1 million by coinciding with Phase IV Industrial Park.

Phase IV UAS Industrial Park: \$10-\$12 million infrastructure project (\$7-\$9m City; \$3m Economic Development Administration Grant).

PDT Inc. Hangar Project: \$600k for private t-hangars.

PAEISR Box Hangar: This \$2.5 million construction project will use low-interest State loan to erect 3-bay hangar for PAEISR, 62<sup>nd</sup> largest Defense Contractor in the world. PAE, which already employs over two dozen people here, has committed to renting this hangar for at least 5 years.

It's important to understand that we have a plan, which has been working very well, and that we would never make these investments if we were not very confident that we could build on our past success.

## VOLUNTEERS

### Adopt a Park or Parkway

The City of Pendleton maintains 22 parks and landscaped areas for the benefit of the community. The parks all have something different to offer, with shelters, stages and sports fields and courts available to reserve. The Adopt-A-Park program was brought back several years ago after being dormant, inviting volunteers to help keep the parks litter free by committing to a specific park or area. Adopt-A-Parkway was added, helping to keep the river walk beautiful for all to enjoy. Volunteers make an annual commitment to pick up litter at a frequency of their choice, and report graffiti and vandalism to staff. Currently there are 10 community organizations and businesses and five individuals who help maintain 15 of the parks and landscaped areas around the city and 23 of 25 sections of the River Parkway – 2.5 miles – have been adopted by volunteer individuals and organizations.



For families, businesses and community organizations, adopting a park or parkway is a fun way to work together outdoors while making an impact on the community they live and work in.
