Help the City Set Its Priorities



In 2016, the City attended dozens of meetings to get our citizens' ideas on what they wanted their City Council to work on. Stated differently, we asked you what was

most important. Four areas rose to the top and they became our City Goals in January 2017. So, for the past four years, our City Goals have been:

Provide sustainable funding to fix infrastructure (with streets being the main effort).

Provide more housing for all levels of income.

Expand the economy, and

Develop more attractive commercial and industrial property.

Your City Council wants to make sure that we are still working on the most important issues and we are starting an electronic survey (using *Survey Monkey*) to reach as many citizens as possible. The survey will go out to all our civic and service organizations, the members of the City Committees and Commissions, and to the people who sign up to read the City newsletter each month. We are very open to sending this survey to other organizations, but we want to ask people to only vote one time, even if they belong to several of the groups listed above.

When you open your survey you will see a list of 11 ideas to rate. We ask that you only mark five of the choices. If you don't see an idea that is important to you and you want to vote for it, there is a place at the bottom of the survey where you can type in your idea.

CURENT OPENINGS ON CITY BOARDS/COMMITTEES/COMMISSIONS

The City of Pendleton offers many opportunities for citizens to volunteer and serve in the community. Currently we have openings on the following committees/commissions;

HISTORICAL PRESERVATIONS COMMITTEE Is looking for applicants that have a background in history, architecture, architectural history, archaeology, or related fields or have demonstrated a POSITIVE interest, competence, or knowledge in historic preservation.

Members need to have these qualifications to maintain Certified Local Government standing with the State Historic Preservation Commission. This opens door for the City and its citizens to obtain grants, assistance, recognition, and recommendations: for example the Main Street grant.

AIRPORT COMMISSION - (Ordinance No. 2493) 11 members: no more than 5 non-residents, 3 may reside more than 20 miles from the city. 3 year terms; expiring in December of each year; 2 ex-officio members: Airport Manager & Mayor. No more than 3 expire each year.

BUDGET COMMITTEE - Provided by State law. Consists of Mayor, Council Members and 9 citizen members appointed by City Council; 3 year terms; expiring in December of each year.






