### Introduction

### City of Pendleton Communications Survey

The Pendleton City Council has set improving communications between the Community and the City Council/Mayor's Office/City of Pendleton as one of the primary council goals. In the summer of 2022, the City launched a communications survey designed to help gauge current conditions and guide communication decisions.

#### Methodology

The City of Pendleton Communications Survey 2022 ("the survey") was conducted via SurveyMonkey, an online-based survey software. Hard copies of the survey were made available at Pendleton City Hall. The survey link was sent out via the City of Pendleton Facebook page, in the City Newsletter, and included in the July insert in Pendleton utility bills, which are mailed to all utility customers. A press release went out to local media on July 1, and the East Oregonian newspaper both ran the press release and had an editorial discussing the survey (see Appendix B).

The survey opened on July 1, 2022 and closed on August 15, 2022. Those who completed the survey before July 31 and provided contact information, either an email address or phone number, were entered into a drawing for one of four \$25 gift cards. Of the 284 survey responses received by July 31, 87 percent provided contact information for a chance to win one of the gift cards. Winning numbers were drawn on Aug. 1.

In total, 340 participants took the communications survey with a completion rate of 100%. The survey took participants an average time of 7 minutes 26 seconds to complete with most participants answering all questions. The most-skipped question was Question 14: What would you change on the City of Pendleton website; 135 participants skipped this open-ended question.

#### Report Format

This report breaks down the information gathered in the City of Pendleton Communications Survey 2022. The survey included 20 questions that fit into five main categories. In this report, these are broken down under the following headings:

- About the Participants: Demographics of the participants, including time spent in Pendleton
- About the Information Sources: Where participants found information about the City of Pendleton
- About Communication: Overall feelings about the City of Pendleton and its communication
- About the Website: Use of the City of Pendleton website
- Suggestions for Improvement: open-ended questions for participants to provide feedback and share stories of communication

This report also includes an executive summary and suggestions for next steps. Full survey questions and answers are included in Appendix A.



### **Summary**

Survey participants felt informed about the City of Pendleton but suggest the city has room for improvement across all communication channels.

More than half (56%) of survey respondents felt well informed or somewhat informed about the City of Pendleton. The same percentage (56%) also felt the City of Pendleton does not share information *often* enough, and slightly more participants (57%) said the city does not share *enough* information.

Participants were most likely to find information about the City of Pendleton on social media, followed by the City of Pendleton website, and then news media. Participants said the City of Pendleton is communicating well through Facebook, newsletters, and press releases, although there is room for improvement. Survey respondents who use social media felt the City's Facebook page is well run, and response to the city's website was mixed.

Overall, participants want the City to share more information and to share information more often. The top categories participants want to hear about are construction, City Council and administrative decisions, emergency preparedness, and economic development. Multiple respondents commented that having this kind of survey was a step in the right direction. Survey participants would like opportunities to interact and provide feedback.

The full survey and responses are included in the Appendix A.

"The city is trying really hard to improve communication which is great, however communication is a 2-way street and the city leadership could definitely improve on their listening skills."



### About the Participants

The City of Pendleton Communications Survey received 340 responses.

Of those participants, most (332) provided demographic information on age, number of years in Pendleton and whether they lived/worked within the City. Participants ranged across all age categories, but the majority (56%) of participants were between the ages of 18 and 39. Age categories included Under 18 (1.21%), 18-29 (26.28%), 30-39 (30.21%), 40-49 (18.73%), 50-59 (12/69%), or 60+ (10.27%). Of the participants, 90% lived in the City of Pendleton and 84% worked in the City of Pendleton.

Although the survey respondents included non-residents, new residents, and longtime residents, the largest groups of survey participants were split between newer residents, those who have lived in the City of Pendleton for 1-5 years (23.87%), and longtime residents who have lived in the city for 26 years or more (22.66%).

Longtime Pendleton residents were most likely to feel very informed or not informed at all about the City of Pendleton. Of participants who said they felt well informed about the city, 48.57% had lived in the city of Pendleton 21



90 percent of survey participants live in the City of Pendleton, and 84% work in Pendleton

years or more. Of those who responded "Not informed at all," 64.29% had lived in the city of Pendleton more than 20 years.

#### **About the Information Sources**

Participants were most likely to find information about the City of Pendleton from Facebook, including pages for City Departments (such as Parks and Recreation or the Pendleton Public Library), the City Facebook page, and community Facebook Groups. One-third of survey respondents found information on the City's Website, but only 15% responded the City Website was the place they used most often to find information.


When asked what information source they used the most often to find information about the City of Pendleton, survey participants responding with the City Facebook page (25%), a department Facebook page (21%), the City website (15%) and Community Facebook Groups (9%). Some participants reported using local print media (8%), Twitter (7%), local online media (6%) and Instagram (2.4%) as the primary source for city information.

Those who said they felt well informed about the City of Pendleton were the group most likely to find information on the City's website (28.57%). Those who were "somewhat informed" primarily used the City's Facebook age as an information source (30%).

#### **About Communication**

In the question, "Overall, how informed do you feel about the City of Pendleton," more than half of participants felt somewhat informed or well informed about the city. Seventy-four participants (22%) gave a neutral answer to the question, and less than a quarter, 22% felt "not very informed" or "not informed at all."

More than 50% of survey respondents felt the city does not share information often enough and that the city does not share enough information when it communicates. Only 5% of respondents thought the city shares too much information.



Participants weighed in on what types of information they would like the city to share. Participants could select as many options as applied from a list that included 16 different topics (See Figure 4 for full list) and a space for "Other."

Overall, the most selected topics were Construction (62%), City Council Meetings and Decisions (53%), Emergency Preparedness and Response (52%), Public Safety (52%) and Economic Development (49%).

Those who checked the box for "Other" could provide specifics. Here are some of those answers:


- Long term plans for running the city
- Why are sewer and water rates SO HIGH???



- New building permit approvals, so we'll have an idea about projects being built around town. These used to be reported in the city's monthly newsletter.
- Public safety information such as areas seeing increase in crimes
- Notification to effected businesses that the entrance will be blocked so your clients cannot enter.
- All the above
- Special events
- Explanation of overall strategies and philosophies of city government and economic development

In addition to selecting what topics the city should share, participants were also able to rank the types of information most important to them. Participants chose the three most important categories, marking one as "most important," one as "second most important," and one as "third most important."

To calculate the weighted value, topics chosen as "most important" were given a weight of three, topics chosen as "second most important" were given a weight of two, and topics with a weight of "third most important" were given a weight of one. Find the weighted values as percentages in Figure 5.

A comparison of the topic rankings between Question 4 and Question 5 can be found in Figure 6.

The information from Question 5 aligned closely, but not exactly, with the information participants would like to know more about. City Council Meetings and Decisions was the most answered topic in both the most important and second most important categories, giving it a weighted average of 14%, higher than the weight average of the importance of construction (12%). This suggests that while participants are most

interested in hearing more about construction, information about City Council is slightly more important to participants.

In the survey, Question 15 focuses specifically on information and awareness of City Council meetings and City Council decisions. In that area, almost all participants fell into one of two categories: Yes, but there is room for improvement (44%) or No, I am not aware and would like to learn more (37%). Participants could also answer "Yes, I feel well informed" or "No, but this is not a priority for me."

One survey participant commented, "(The City of Pendleton) informs us well on projects, but I seem to hear about it after the fact. I'd like to hear about things that are still being discussed or voted on."


#### About the Website

Multiple of the questions in the survey focused on the City of Pendleton's website,  $\underline{\text{https://pendleton.or.us/}}$ . On a scale of 1 to 10, survey respondents

rated the website an average score of six. Numbers ranged between a rating of 1, the lowest possible rating, and 10, the highest rating. The most common rating was 7, at 26% of the responses, followed by 8, then 5.

Survey participants were split on the effectiveness of the City website. Although 39% of respondents said the website was easy to use, only 34% said they could typically find the information they were looking for. When asked "How well do you agree with the statement, 'I can usually find

Figure 7: On a scale of 1 to 10, how would you rate the City of Pendleton's website?






the information I am looking for on the City of Pendleton website," 21.75% of participants disagreed.

There appears to be a correlation between participants who did not feel informed about the City of Pendleton and ability to access information on the City website. Half of participants who responded they did not feel informed about the City of Pendleton also disagreed with the statement "I can usually find the information I need on the City of Pendleton website." Within the participants who did not feel informed at all about the City of Pendleton, only 7% could usually find needed information on the City of Pendleton's website.

This correlation applies across categories of how well informed participants felt. Of those participants who responded that they were "well informed" about the City of Pendleton, 71.41% found information about the City of Pendleton on the City's website. This is compared to only 34% of those who

were "somewhat informed" who found information on the City's website, 24% of those who responded neutral, and 22% of those who responded "not very informed." Of those participants who do not feel informed at all, 28% used the City's website to find information.

A conclusion from this could be participants are more likely to feel informed if they can find information on the website.

# "Navigation is very clumsy unless you know exactly what you are looking for."

Although 33 percent of participants said they did find information about the City of Pendleton on the City Website, only 15% used the website as their primary information source, compared to 25% who use the City Facebook page and 21% who primarily use a Department Facebook page.

The most common frequency for visiting the City's website was "a few times per month," followed by once a week. About 21% of respondents visit the website "a few times per year," and in the survey, 51 participants, or 15%, do not regularly visit the City Website.

What would you change on the City of Pendleton website?

- Most recent information pertaining to our city be posted first. Make the search bar more user friendly
- I would love to see some photos of what makes Pendleton awesome and beautiful, right in my face when I first land on the website
- Easier navigation
- More mobile device friendly
- Color and font
- Although much better than it was a few years ago, the website is still static and not engaging

### Suggestions for Improvement

Throughout the survey, participants had opportunities to comment on what is going well and what could be improved in City of Pendleton communications. The final survey question gave participants an open-ended opportunity to weigh in on how to improve City Communications. Multiple participants asked for more updates on social media, and multiple people stressed having social media and website pages updated with accurate information.

Another recurring theme throughout the feedback was having opportunities for community members to provide feedback or reach out before decisions are made.

Here are some of the comments:

- I would enjoy better access to city councilors, maybe a regular open forum for discussion, outside of the comment period at Council meetings.
- I think the community would be better serviced if the city leadership would spend less time TALKING about what they think their important projects are and more time LISTENING to the needs of the businesses.
- Transparency and details, especially when things are changing. Folks
  want to know what's being built, they need to know when service or
  access is going to be disrupted, and they want to know what events are
  happening.
- Have regular survey's like this. Maybe have a citizen's advisory counsel, maybe you have one, but it isn't clearly stated. Thank you.

#### Survey comment:

"Would love to hear more about activities, programs, classes, parks and rec stuff more often. And more formal options for city feedback. Outside of leaving comments on Facebook posts, a real structured options for feedback and q and a would be great"

Many comments referenced city representatives not communicating or an overall negative impression of the city. Positive communication and opening opportunities for engagement could help resolve that issue.



Some feedback was department or location specific, such as the reader board at the Pendleton Convention Center or the Path to Success initiative. The full comments are included in the Appendix.

Multiple survey participants also gave suggestions for improvement the City is already doing; this suggests the City of Pendleton could do more to promote existing programs. For example, multiple respondents said City Council meetings should be available live online, and city meetings are currently streamed online through Zoom.

#### **Next Steps**

Overall, the next steps should be to share more information, more often, and to let the community know of initiatives, programs, and meetings already taking place.

In addressing construction, the City is currently working on a projects page that will provide community members some of the information requested. The website committee should evaluate the feedback and update the City of Pendleton website with more current information and easier navigation using the website-specific feedback.

To increase engagement, the City could also consider some sort of Q and A or other feedback solution to actively engage with community members. The City could do more to give interested community members a chance to provide that feedback and interaction.

Repeating the survey at a future date would give information on whether those methods were successful.

"I think the City has information available for people that want it."

### Our view: Survey could be beneficial to city

The Pendleton City Council is on the right path with its devotion to fulfilling its goal to improve communication with the community.

Last week, the city announced it has launched the Pendleton Communications Survey 2022 to help solicit feedback from residents.

Any time elected and appointed officials can gather input from voters it is a good step forward. In the digital world we now live in people and cities can become isolated inside selfmade silos where information is either stunted or slanted.

For government to work effectively several goals must be met on a consistent basis. For one, voters must always keep a keen eye on the decisions made by elected and appointed leaders. Our government works for us. Which means its decisions must be based on constructive feedback from citizens.

There is no shortage of communication in our world now. From social media platforms to bloggers, the number of opinions thrown across the public stage is monumental. The trouble is, all of those voices — those opinions — blend together and become a single, long scream of white noise.

Collecting feedback that is narrowly focused and with an established goal is crucial and the communications survey does that. The key, though, will be the kind of feedback the city receives. Long narratives of political bombast are fine for national television but hardly the ingredients to help a relatively small-town council pave a way forward.

Pendleton residents essentially have a terrific opportunity to give feedback to their elected leaders. In an ideal world, throngs of citizens would attend council meetings and give feedback during the public comment period at each session. The reality, though, is we all live very busy lives and attendance at most city — or even county — public meetings is never robust.

Yet now the city has created an avenue for voters to use to get their input before their elected leaders. Such input, if done in a methodical and civil manner, can go a long way toward helping the city in the future. In the end, our goals should be similar. A nice city that is safe and clean that is welcoming to all.

The city is on the right track with this survey, and we hope it proves to be a successful model for the future
