### Community Discussion:

- ◆ Chad Miltenberger spoke to the council about having younger people get involved in City government and to check for any updates on the question of a loading zone in front of his business, Sign Men.

**Consent Agenda:** The consent agenda groups routine meeting actions into a single agenda item so they can be approved in one step, rather than in multiple motions.

- ✓ Minutes of the May 21, 2024, City Council meeting; adoption of Transit FTA Procurement Policy; Adoption of Transit Financial Management of Federal Awards Policy

### Bids

- ✓ Bid Award: Well 11/11B Wellhouses Project: The council voted to award the bid for construction of the wellhouses for Well 11 and Well 11B to low bidder Rotschy Inc in the amount of \$1,805,822.15.
- ✓ Bid Award: Materials for SW Tutuilla Road Water Main Extension Project: This project will extend the existing 12" main on Tutuilla Rd from SW Tahoe south to the City Limits. This extended main will provide water service, as well as fire flow to the south edge of our service area. A purchase order was approved to HD Fowler for \$65,151.15.

### Public Hearings and Related Ordinances and Resolutions

- ✓ Resolution 2936, Supplemental Budget: A This supplemental budget requests additional funding or adjustments for various City funds, including increasing costs for the fire department personnel and operations for increased catering revenue and expenses at the Pendleton Convention Center.
- ✓ Resolution 2938, State Revenue Sharing : ORS 221.770 requires the City to pass an ordinance or resolution electing to receive State Revenue Sharing monies. For FY24-25, \$200,000 in state revenue sharing will support public safety programs. These funds come from state taxes on the sale of liquor.

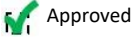

### Public Hearings and Related Ordinances and Resolutions

-  Resolution 2937, Adopting FY 24-25 Budget: *Resolution 2937 adopts the budget for FY 2024-25 as approved by the Budget Committee at their May 14, 2024, meeting. The total for all funds is \$109,697,385*

### New Business

- ◆ First Reading of Ordinance 4017 to amend Ordinance 2775, the Sign Code, incorporating signage regulations within a historic district: *The Sign Code lacks any criteria to review murals and electronic message centers (EMCs). In 2023, staff proposed a moratorium on any new signs of those types to develop sign criteria for signage in the Historic District. The Planning Commission and Historic Preservation Commission agreed that the Downtown Historic District, should have distinctive signage from the rest of Pendleton and presented signage regulations within the historic district. No vote is taken on a first reading.*
- ◆ First Reading of Ordinance 4019, Repealing Ordinance 3532, the Adoption of Oregon Electrical Code: *Staff recommended that the electrical code be included in the specialty code for ease of use and simplicity instead of in a separate ordinance. While moving the Electrical Code to the Specialty Codes Ordinance, the repeal of the old stand-alone electrical code ordinance needs to be repealed, as it is no longer necessary. No vote is taken on a first reading.*
