- ◆ Ordinance 4004, amending Ordinance 3238, controlling vehicular and pedestrian traffic: *This amendment transfers responsibility for overseeing special parking permits from the City Manager to the Police Department. No public testimony was presented.*

- ◆ Resignation of Municipal Court Judge: *Municipal Court Judge Blaine Clooten submitted his letter of recognition effective December 29, 2023. Staff recommended appointing Kent Bendixsen to serve as Interim Municipal Court Judge and a three-week period for interested parties to submit applications to fill the position.*
