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New Business

- First Reading, Amending the Fire Code Ordinance 4014: The Oregon Fire Code is generally adopted every three years, coinciding with the publication of a nationally recognized fire code. No vote is taken on a first reading.
- M Approval of Flex Hangar III Architectural Contract Award: Building a new flex hangar at the UAS range will bring in new lease revenue, and the City has \$1.4 million remaining on an Economic Development Administration grant that will pay for the project. The Flex Hangar III architectural contract at the airport was awarded to Aron Faegre Architect for \$103,200
 - Approval of B-17 Hangar (CIE) Renovation CMGC Award: The CIE Renovation Project would allow the entire ground floor of the B-17 Hangar to be functional for the first time in decades. Council approved the of CIE Renovation Project and awarded the CM/GC Contract to McCormack Construction
