Consent Agenda:

 Minutes of the March 21, 2023, meeting, announcement of executive session to discuss labor negotiations; OLCC Permit approval for Sarah's Sweet & Savory; confirmation of Kris Mulvihill to the Tree Commission.

Public Hearing:

 Ordinance 3998, amending Ordinance 3469, the LID ordinance: *The City's LID (low impact development) ordinance does not include a provision for penalty or late charge for past due LID payments. This updated LID process is designed to incentivize timely LID payments by adding late charges of \$35 for LID payments of less than \$500 and a charge of \$35 plus 10% of the payment past due for LID payments of \$500 or more. No public testimony received.*

New Business:

- ◆ Arts Commission Annual Report: *Charles Denight presented on recent and planned activities from the Arts Commission.*
-  NW Despain Avenue: City Council Construction Consideration between North Main and NW 7th Streets: *NW Despain Avenue has deteriorated and needs to be reconstructed. City staff's proposal included widening the street to narrow traffic lanes and add a parking lane on the north side. After public comment opposing the proposal from City staff, Council opted to instead rebuild the street at its current width.*
