 Award Patching Work to Interstate Concrete and Asphalt: *Public Works has a need for patching services throughout the year to repair various utility cuts, unforeseen damage areas, etc. This authorizes up to \$200,000 to be spent on asphalt patching during the 2024 construction season.*

Public Hearings and Related Ordinances and Resolutions

 Public Hearing on Ordinance 4014 to Repeal Fire Code: *The Oregon Fire Code is generally adopted every three years. This ordinance brings Pendleton into compliance with the new code.*

New Business

 ODOT Agreement 73-52717 for Goad Road – SE Kirk Avenue – Connector Road: *The City of Pendleton received \$1.5 million federal funding for development and construction of a connector road from Hwy 11 to Hwy 30. This allocation requires a local match of 10.27%, or \$171,681.72., from the City. This funding will come from the Transportation System Development Fee Fund or the Streets Fund and will be used for a new roadway located within the ROW.*

 East End Reimbursement District: SE 15th Street Project: Development Agreement: *The developer of the Summit View Ridge Subdivision, TAC Land LLC, will provide final design for the SE 15th Street roadway improvements.*
