



- Arbor Day Proclamation read by the Mayor
- Recognition of Andrea Denton, who is retiring as HR manager at the end of this month, and introduction of new the HR Manager, Sheri Allen.

## Consent Agenda:

Minutes of the April 4, 2023, meeting, approval of OLCC permit for Los Chilaquiles; approval of OLCC permit for Flying X Speakeasy and Lounge; announcement of executive session to discuss property transactions.

## **Public Hearing:**

Resolution 2895 Authorizing Transfer of Land Interest to RCDC and Declaring Land Surplus: In March, the Round-Up City Development Corporation asked the city to contribute 40 acres of property west of the airport for development of a youth sports complex. This resolution indicates the city's willingness to contribute the property when RCDC secures the necessary funding to proceed with the project. Only one member of the public spoke, and he spoke in favor of the project.

### **New Business:**

- Solid Waste Advisory Board Annual Report: Presentation from the Solid Waste Advisory Board. Much of this discussion centered on the state of Oregon's Plastic Pollution and Recycling Modernization Act, which will require the City of Pendleton to go to curb-side recycling by 2025.
- Parks and Recreation Commission Annual Report: Presentation on recent and planned activities from the Parks and Recreation.
- Ordinance 3999 Amending Ordinance 3988, the Resting Ordinance, First Reading: This ordinance clarifies the process for giving exclusion orders. No vote is taken on first reading; a public hearing and vote are scheduled for May 2.
