New Business:

 **Proposal Award: Ducote Consulting for Labor Standards Administration:** *This sets a contract with Ducote Consulting for three years for Labor Standards Administration for utilities Capital Improvement Program projects, replacing the contract with GEODC that ended on June 30. Ducote Consulting has been working as a subcontractor with GEODC for a year and a half.*

 **Ordinance 4002 establishes the CPACE program:** *This ordinance would establish the Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy program in Pendleton. CPACE is a financing program with an emphasis on providing private lender loans for energy efficiency, renewable energy, water conservation and seismic retrofits. No vote is taken on first reading.*

 **Amendment to Lodging Room Tax Ordinance 2795: Housekeeping amendment to the Lodging Room Tax Ordinance to clarify enforcement details as a result of the recent revision of the ordinance. No vote is taken on first reading.**
