

New Business:

Approval of ESPC Phase 2, Design & Construction at Wastewater Treatment Plant for Solar Cover Project: This agreement allows for design and construction of a solar panel canopy to cover the chlorine contact chamber at the wastewater treatment resource renewal facility for up to \$1.8 million. This project is being funded through a Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) Community Renewable Energy Program grant and Federal Investment Tax Credit funds. City Council authorized Phase 1, the audit and development of preliminary
