Community Discussion:

- ◆ *No community discussion presented*

Consent Agenda: *The consent agenda groups routine meeting actions into a single agenda item so they can be approved in one step, rather than in multiple motions.*

-  Minutes of the Aug. 15 council meeting; amendment to federal lobby contract with CFW Strategic Communications to increase monthly payment from \$4,267 to \$4,291; approval of Resolution 2913, adding utility leasing section to airport leasing policy

New Business

- ◆ Ordinance 4003, Relating to Municipal Court, becoming a Court of Record: *This action makes the Pendleton Municipal Court (PMC) a court “of record,” eliminating excessing transfers/appeals to Circuit Court. The FTR cloud based recording system will cost \$415 per month, but keeping fines and fees for local cases at PMC should offset the costs. No vote is taken on a first reading.*
-  Resolution 2914 – I-84 Exit 209 Improvements – Reconnecting Communities and Neighborhoods (RNC) Grant Application: *Allows city staff to apply for grant funding for improvements to I-84 Exit 209 and to SW Perkins Avenue. The City is applying for a \$20 million grant for Phase 1 of the project, which would upgrade the north side of the interchange as well as build an extension of SW Perkins to connect to Tutuilla.*
-  Approval of Resolution 2915 Authorizing an SDWSRF Loan for no more than \$6,901,320 : *Funding will be used to replace a 1910/1912 concrete water line with a new 30-inch water line, provide a new 18-inch water line for domestic and fire flow, and other identified master planning projects based on construction costs.*
