 Resolution Approving Expansion of the Pilot Rock-Pendleton Enterprise Zone:
The Pilot Rock-Pendleton Enterprise Zone was created in the early 2000s and renewed in 2019. This resolution adds 565 acres to the existing area..

 Bus Barn Proposal Ranking: *The City of Pendleton seeks a professional Construction Manager / General Contractor firm to complete the construction phase of work related to a new bus barn facility for the City's transit program. Two proposals were received. Selection Team recommended ranking McCormack Construction first and Kirby Nagelhout Construction second.*

 Road Construction Franklin Grade, Horizon Project:
Agreement for City Participation in Costs of Construction of Franklin Grade Road Development, up to, but not to exceed \$749,999. This will be funded from utility, street, and possibly SDC funds.
