Consent Agenda: *The consent agenda groups routine meeting actions into a single agenda item so they can be approved in one step, rather than in multiple motions.*

-  *Minutes of the Oct. 10, 2023; Proclamation celebrating Altrusa's 85th Birthday; announcement of executive session to discuss real property transactions.*

Public Hearings

-  First Reading of Ordinance 4006, amending Ordinance 3845, the UDC, and Ordinance 3442: *This ordinance rezones 5.04 acres of land between Oxford Suites and Thoroughbred Carwash from M-1 Light Industrial to CMU Central-Mixed Use at the request of the property owners and property neighbors. No vote is taken on a first reading.*

Bids

-  Award Consideration for the East End Booster Pump Station Project: *Mike Becker General Contractor was the project low bidder at just under \$2.48 million. This project will be funded from the Business Oregon Special Public Works Fund, and the new booster pump station will provide water pressure for new development around Interstate 84 Exit 210.*

New Business

- ◆ Information Technology (IT): Award of Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Hermiston for IT Services: *The current IGA for ongoing IT support services expires Oct. 31, 2023. This would extend the contract from Nov. 1 to June 30, 2024 and increase the monthly billed rate from \$12,500 a month to \$12,875 a month.*
- ◆ Judge Pro-Tem Selection: *The Pendleton Municipal Court maintains a pool of judge pro-tem candidates for court cases where the judge is unavailable or has a conflict of interest. This adds Cameron Bendixsen as a third judge in that pool.*
