





## Bid Award:

Well 11 Bid Award: Council awarded the contract for the Well No. 11B Drilling Project to Holt Services, of Milton, WA, for \$782,023. The existing Well No. 11, which serves the Wastewater Treatment Resource Recovery Facility, is too small to be developed for the municipal water supply. The new well will be drilled near the existing well to provide water for the WWTRRF and the water distribution system.

## New Business:



Ordinance 3992, amending Ordinance 2795, the Room Tax Ordinance: In 2020, the Oregon Department of Revenue began collection of local room taxes for local governments who opted to receive that service. After about one year of DOR's collection service, city staff concluded that it is not working well for the City and that we should discontinue DOR's collection services and resume our own local room tax administration.

Contract with the City of Hermiston for IT services: IMESD is ending IT service for the City of Pendleton to focus on its highest priority: school districts' IT needs. To replace that service, the City executed an Internet Service Provider contract with Wtechlink and presented an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) for ongoing network support services with the City of Hermiston. This vote approved the IGA with City of

Hermiston, whose Council approved the IGA at their Monday Council meeting, for ongoing network support services.
