- First Reading of Ordinance 4007 to amend Ordinance 3845 the UDC and Ordinance 3442, the Comprehensive Plan: This changes the zoning of the Reese and Water Filtration Plan property from EFU Exclusive Farm Use to M-1 Light Industrial to allow for property development. No vote is taken on a first reading.

Consor - Task Order No. 26 - North Hill Pressure Zones—Assessment and Design Concept: This seven-month assessment would outline design and construction considerations for a project to address some fire flow deficiencies and stagnant water in the Skyline pressure system and allow for potential service to a new higher level pressure zone for development north of the existing City Limits. The task order allows for up to \$145,033.
