Bids

Connector Road Waterlines Project—Rotschy Inc.: Rotschy Inc was the low bidder with an estimate of \$4.03 million to install a new domestic waterline in the area known as the Rees-Goad property. The engineering estimate was \$6 million, which will allow additional projects to be completed.

√ 3/4 minus trench backfill rock to American Rock Products: Pendleton Public Works has a need for ¾ minus rock throughout the year to backfill utility cuts in the road system. This authorizes up to \$200,000 to pay for rock throughout the 2024 construction season.

Public Hearings and related ordinances

Public Hearing of Ordinance 4007 to amend Ordinance 3845, the UDC, and Ordinance 3442, Comp Plan: This ordinance would change 54.97 acres of land recently annexed into city limits off Goad Road from Exclusive Farm Use to M-1 Light Industrial for development. Council will vote on re-zoning portions of the land to R-1 in January. No public testimony was presented.

New Business

- First Reading of Ordinance 4004, amending Ordinance 3238, an ordinance controlling vehicular and pedestrian traffic: Ordinance 3238 regulates elements of Taxi Business and special parking permits for a variety of purposes, including special parking permits for construction projects in the downtown. This transfers responsibility for overseeing this program to the Police Department. No vote is taken on a first reading.
- First Reading of Ordinance 3898, Amending the Street Tree Ordinance. Pressure Zones—Assessment and Design Concept: This seven-month assessment would outline design and construction considerations for a project to address some fire flow deficiencies and stagnant water in the Skyline pressure system and allow for potential service to a new higher level pressure zone for development north of the existing City Limits. The task order allows for up to \$145,033. No vote is taken on a first reading
