This Addendum provides the following clarifications/revisions, corrections and changes to the Bid Documents. All bidders shall acknowledge receipt and acceptance of this Addendum by completing the spaces, signing where indicated below and submitting it with the Proposal. Bids submitted without signing for the Addendum may be considered informal.

1. REPLACE Section 6.00 BIDDER'S QUALIFICATIONS, Page 1, with the attached which includes the following changes:

1. **Minimum Experience Requirement:** Bidders shall have successfully completed a minimum of one (1) Reference Project as the Prime Contractor for the installation of publicly owned well with an original contract amount greater than ~~\$1,000,000~~ **\$500,000** within the past seven (7) years. Completion shall be measured by the date the project was determined to be substantially complete by the Owner. **Contractor must document to the Owner that the Contractor has successfully constructed at least three (3) wells similar to those required in this Contract and that the Contractor has the experience, qualifications, and equipment necessary to perform the required Work.**

2. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS, SECTION 1, WATER WELLS:

Completion shall be measured by the date the project was determined to be substantially complete by the Owner. Contractor must document to the Owner that the Contractor has successfully constructed at least three (3) wells similar to those required in this Contract and that the Contractor has the experience, qualifications, and equipment necessary to perform the required Work.
2. **Project Manager and Onsite Construction Superintendent/Foreman:** The Bidder shall provide an experienced Project Manager and Onsite Construction Superintendent/Foreman that has served in the same role a minimum of one of the three Reference Projects while employed by the Bidder. Attach a detailed resume and current workload summary for the proposed Project Manager and Onsite Construction Superintendent/Foreman. No substitution of the Project Manager and Onsite Construction Superintendent/Foreman shall be allowed by the Owner at any time during construction. The Owner reserves the right to approve the Contractor's proposed Project Manager and Onsite Construction Superintendent/Foreman. The Owner reserves the right to request a formal interview with the Bidder's proposed Project Manager and Onsite Construction Superintendent/Foreman prior to award of the Contract.

Failure to provide Qualifications acceptable to the Owner may result in the Bid being declared non-responsive by the Owner. Determination of a non-responsive Bid shall be at the sole discretion of the Owner.
