This project is phase two of a multi-phase project to upgrade ADA ramps throughout Pendleton.

We will construct curb ramps to meet compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. Work also includes:

- Replace asphalt walkway with wider concrete sidewalk on east side of U.S. 395, from Southwest Tutuilla Road to Southwest Perkins Avenue.
- Install flashing beacons on OR 11 at:
 - SE Isaac Avenue.
 - SE 17th Street.
- Reconfigure lane to add bike lanes on OR 11, from the I-84 interchange to Southeast Court Avenue.
